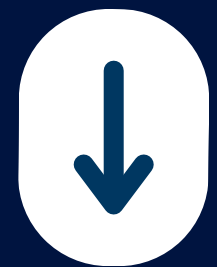


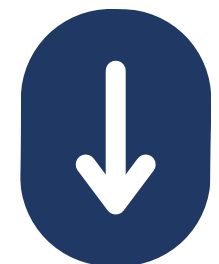
Rosebank Protests

Project Approval:

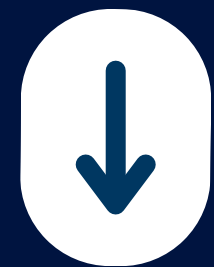
Regulators have given the green light to the Rosebank North Sea oil and gas project.

Rishi Sunak suggested that banning new projects would lead to reliance on expensive imported energy. Keir Starmer indicated he is against revoking newly granted licenses.

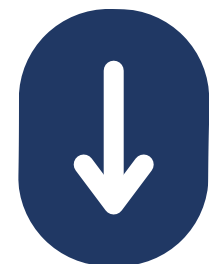

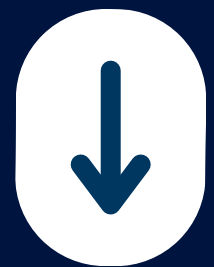


Protest Details:
